

Royalty On

Inspired by a simple royal crown, the Royalty hat is a pill box shaped hat with pointed ridges circling the top. Royalty is worked entirely in single crochet, and goes together very easily.



Instructions:

Sides and trim

1. Chain 11, skip 1st chain and crochet in each chain across (10) ch 1 and turn
2. Working in front loop only, sc in each sc across, ch1 turn.
- 3 – 70 Repeat row 2
4. Turn to work along edge of ribbing, sc in end of each row (70 sc). Join with slip stitch to first sc and sew seam together using a slip stitch, matching ribbing pattern. Do not tie off
5. For bottom edging, sc in end of 1st row, ch3, sc in end of next row around, join with a slip stitch in first sc. Fasten off.

Triangles:

Join yarn at top with a sc. Work triangle pattern around. fasten off

Top

Special Stitch join: at the end of each row join with a slip stitch, then ch1 and SC in joined stitch – which counts as the first stitch of the next row.

1. Ch 2, 12 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join. (12)
2. 2 sc in each sc around, join (24)
3. *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc* around, join (36)
4. Sc in next sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc* around, 2 sc in next sc. (48)
5. Sc in next 2sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc* around, 2 sc in next sc. (60)
6. Sc in next 3sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc* 5 times, sc in next 5 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc* 5 times, sc in next sc. (70) Do not fasten off.

Triangles

Work triangle pattern around edge of hat.

Sew triangle edges of each piece of hat together with yarn needle. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Materials:

Worsted weight yarn
(Red Heart used in this photo)

Size H hook

Difficulty:

Easy

Gauge:

8 sc—7 rows = 2 inches.

Special Stitch:

Triangles

1. SC in 1st sc, ch1, sc in same sc. Slip stitch in next two sc of foundation row, ch1 turn
2. Skip 1st slip stitch, sc in next slip stitch, sc in next 2 sc, ch1 turn.
3. SC in 1st 3 sc, sl stitch in next 2 foundation stitches, ch1, turn
4. Skip 1st slip stitch, sc in next sl stitch and each sc across, ch1 turn
5. SC in next 4 sc, slip stitch in next foundation stitch.
